



Development Gliders Endorsement: Uncertified Sub 20m² Paragliders

Sub 20m² paragliders are a new part of the sport of paragliding. By utilizing smaller wings (and thus higher wing loadings) pilots are able to fly in higher wind speeds. This approach is well proven in sailing disciplines, where it is entirely normal to vary the sail size to suit the prevailing wind conditions, but it is a new approach in paragliding. As with anything new, there may be unanticipated dangers for the pilot. Because Sub 20m² paragliders are a new development, virtually all the gliders available for this activity are as yet uncertified. This means that there is no independent verification of their airworthiness. Flying uncertified gliders involves increased risks for the pilot.

The 'Development Gliders Endorsement: Uncertified Sub 20m² Paragliders' allows those pilots who have chosen to get involved in this new activity to do so whilst complying with BHPA Rules and Regulations.
