If a club uses a photocopy of an Ordnance Survey Map in its site guide without a license then the club is infringing Copyright and is liable to prosecution. The same applies if hand drawings are made from an OS map. However, for the cost of £47.50 (plus VAT) a Business Users License can be obtained which covers the club for the year in which a new site guide is produced. A licence is not then required again until the guide is re-written. If the map is reproduced on the web then the license is renewed annually. To obtain a licence go to www.ordnancesurvey.co.uk go to the link 'Copyright and Trademark' to apply on-line. You will also need to acknowledge Crown Copyright and qoute your licence number in the guide.
