### 4: POWER TRAINING

The BHPA have published a new version of the Student Training Record Book for Paragliding (power) training. This new version includes an updated syllabus which has been revised to cater for sub 70kg wheeled types as well as foot launched types. It is available from the office to any BHPA schools offering powered paragliding tuition.

Members who wish to fly sub-70kg wheeled powered aircraft (of the hang-glider type), have faced an insurance "black hole" as they are covered when they are qualified, but not while they are under training; unless the training is being conducted by a BHPA powered hang-gliding instructor. There is a severe shortage of people qualified to offer this training. However there are several CAA instructors who train weight-shift microlight flying who have the requisite skill set, and the BHPA exec have agreed to extend cover to members flying these craft as long as they are under training with a suitably qualified CAA flying instructor. Note that is does not mean the instructor benefits from any cover under our policy; unless they are a BHPA registered school.
