

Tandem paramotor activity

The FSC has been recently made aware that some BHPA schools are providing foot launch tandem paramotor flights. The FSC would like to remind pilots and instructors undertaking this activity (or thinking of doing so) that tandem foot launch paramotoring is not a BHPA authorised activity.

In the event of a claim arising from an incident the BHPA third party insurance would not cover you, leaving you personally liable. Additionally, the landowner's indemnity cover would not apply, which could ultimately leave you in a precarious (and expensive) legal position.

Although the BHPA is working towards dual powered paraglider flights with a wheeled undercarriage being acceptable and legal in specific circumstances, please remember that this activity is currently illegal in the UK unless specifically authorised by the CAA.
